Year 7 – 11 - Bus Information 2025-26

I am writing to inform you about the bus transport to St Mary's College for year 7-11 students, the new fares for September, and the way you need to pay for your child's travel now that the school is cashless. SM6 student transport information will be issued direct from the 6th form before the end of the week.

We continue to provide a considerable transport subsidy to keep the service affordable for all.

How to request a place for your child on the bus and a payment option – the bus routes and fare guide are listed below.

To request a place on the bus and to indicate which payment option you would like you must complete a travel form.

How to pay for your travel

All payments must now be paid via ParentPay in advance of your child's travel and there will be no reimbursement for any days not travelled.

Once you have submitted your travel form an initial payment will be added to your ParentPay account, subsequent payments will then be added to your account on either a weekly or termly basis or when your child needs a new 1 way bundle card.

All initial payments must be received by Friday 29th August 2025.

Once payment has been received your child will be given a pass or a 1 way journey bundle card. On the first morning your child returns to school in September they will be able to travel without a pass/card as they will not be distributed until their first day. Once received, they must then show this pass/card to the driver each time they board the bus.

If we do not receive your initial payment your child will not be given a pass. If you fail to pay subsequent payments your child's pass will be revoked and they will not be able to travel until payment is received.

If your child loses their pass, a new pass will be issued at a cost of £10.

Eligibility for Free Transport

All children in year 7- 11 (from Sept 25) who are eligible for free transport and travelling on a school bus will receive their bus pass from the school on their first day. They can travel the first morning without a pass. Once they receive their pass, they must show it to the driver each time they board the bus. If your child loses their pass, a new pass will be issued at a cost of £10.

Students eligible for free transport travelling with Stagecoach or EYMS will be issued a free travel pass QR Code which they will access via their public transport providers 'Bus App'. Pupils will have to scan their QR code each time they board the bus.

If your child is eligible for free travel please indicate this as your payment option.

Eligibility for free transport ends when pupils leave year 11

Eligibility for free transport ends when pupils leave year 11, however, if a student was eligible for free transport in year 11, they will likely be eligible for 16-19 bursary funding. Please speak to the sixth form team for more information on this scheme and how it can help your child (sm6team@smchull.org).

Applying for Free Transport (applicable for students in year 7 – 11 from September 2025)

- if your child is currently in year 7 – 10 and they live in the Hull area their eligibility should automatically roll over unless your circumstances have changed.
- if you live in East Riding you must apply yearly for free transport via the online form on the ERYC website.
- if your child is currently in year 6, new to the school, or you feel they may be eligible and you wish to apply for free transport please visit the relevant HCC or ERYC website.

If you need to apply, we suggest you do this as soon as possible to ensure your application is processed in time for your child to access free travel from September.

For any queries relating to eligibility please contact the relevant council.

Stopping points

Buses will stop at any official stop along the routes. Pupils must put their hand out to stop the bus.

If your child travels on our school bus services, we recommend that only official bus stops are used because they have been fully risk assessed with the transport provider. If you wish for your child to use an alternative stopping point then we recommend you confirm the safety of this location directly with Ellie Rose Travel, as this is a practice that is not supported by the school.

Behaviour

Pupils are expected to behave on the buses and the school has the right to remove any pupil from these services whose behaviour endangers other passengers or is offensive in any way. Bad language is not tolerated. It is always essential that parents instill and support good behaviour
