



KS4 Revision – Easter Half Term

Dear Parent/Carer,

As we move closer to the summer examination period, we are pleased to confirm our programme of **Easter revision sessions** for students in **Years 10 and 11**.

These sessions will run across the Easter holiday for two weeks, beginning **week commencing Monday 30th March**. A detailed timetable outlining the subjects, dates and times of each session is attached to this letter.

The purpose of these sessions is to provide students with additional support as they prepare for their upcoming assessments and examinations. Sessions will focus on areas such as examination technique, targeted practice, key knowledge and guidance from subject specialists. Experience shows that students who take advantage of opportunities such as these often feel more confident and better prepared as they approach the examination period.

Whilst these sessions are voluntary, we would strongly encourage students to attend those that are relevant to their subjects and individual needs. The Easter break provides a valuable opportunity for focused preparation without the demands of the normal school timetable.

Students should also continue to make use of **One Click Revision** alongside attending any relevant sessions. This provides a structured programme of short, focused revision activities across subjects via Google Classroom, designed to help students regularly revisit key knowledge and skills. Continuing to engage with One Click Revision throughout the Easter period will help students maintain momentum and make the most of the support available.

Please note that these sessions take place outside of the normal school term. As such, responsibility for students attending sessions, including arranging safe travel to and from school, rests with home. Students may attend in their own clothes; however, our usual expectations regarding behaviour and conduct remain in place.

Students should enter the school site via Main Reception and must remain only in the areas where revision sessions are taking place.
