

Year 10 Revision & Key Milestones - Autumn Term

Tracked Revision - Phase 1

Although revision has already begun within some departments, immediately after half term we will launch the first phase of our Focused Revision Weeks for subjects that students complete this academic year. During this period, students are encouraged to attend revision sessions either at lunchtime or after school, following the timetable provided on the final page of this letter.

Our expectation is that every student attends a minimum of two sessions per week. Students will receive rewards for attendance, alongside weekly spot prizes and an entry into a grand prize draw at the end of the phase. Attendance at revision will be monitored weekly via Arbor. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the Year Office. This first phase will run for four school weeks starting **week commencing Monday 3**rd **November** and will lead directly into the Christmas mock examinations.

One Click Revision

As part of our support for Year 10 in the build-up to GCSEs, we are launching One Click Revision from Monday 3rd November. This weekly programme provides a short, focused revision task for each subject, accessible via Google Classroom. Students are encouraged to spend around 15 minutes per subject each week, completing tasks at home. Teachers will revisit the previous week's tasks in lessons through short activities or starters. Access is restricted to Year 10 students, but we encourage you to ask your child to show you the programme once it launches.

In addition to this, guidance on revision techniques for students and parents can be found on the school website here. Students who revise independently are more confident going into their exams and give themselves the best chance of success.

KS4 Parents' Evening

Our KS4 Parents' Evening will take place on **Wednesday 12**th **November**. This event provides an important opportunity for you to meet with your child's subject teachers and discuss their progress. This will only be subjects that students complete this academic year. There will be a further event later in the academic year for all other subjects. Full details, including booking arrangements, will be shared after half term.

Winter Mock Season

Year 10 students will sit their mock examinations during the weeks commencing **Monday 1st December** and **Monday 8th December**. A full timetable, along with further guidance, will be shared with you after half term. It is essential that students are present in school for all examinations, so we kindly ask that you avoid booking medical or other routine appointments during this period wherever possible.

Year 10 is a challenging year with high expectations, but please be assured that we are fully committed to supporting our students every step of the way.
